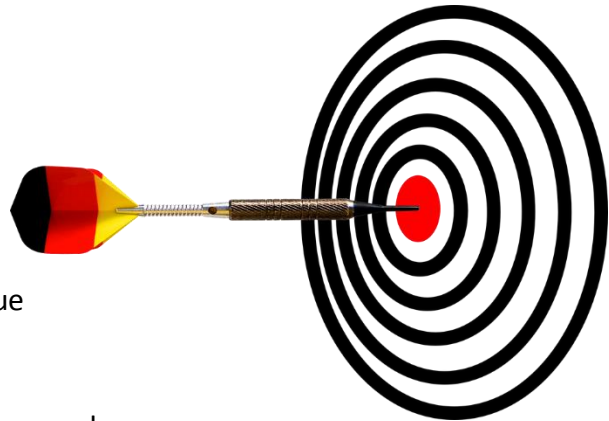


Goal 1,000!



Ages: 5-12

Building Skills In: addition, subtraction, place value

Number of Players: 2-4

Materials: deck of cards with 10 and face cards removed.

Brief Description: Players create two 3-digit numbers and add them together to reach 1,000. Player whose sum is closest to 1,000 wins the round and gets 5 points. The first player to get 25 points wins the game.

Directions:

1. Deal six cards to each player.
2. Each player arranges their cards into two 3-digit numbers.
3. Then, they add the numbers together.
4. Whoever is closest to 1,000 gets five points.
5. Continue playing rounds until a player gets 25 points.

Variations:

- Change the goal to 10, 100, 10, 000, etc. based on the abilities of the players.
- Change the goal to 0 to practice subtraction. Start at 1,000, 100, or 10.
- If you change the goal, here are the guidelines for dealing cards.

Goal	# Cards Dealt	Process Played
100	6 per player	Two digit addition
10	4 per player	Single digit addition
0	2, 4, or 6 per player	Three, two or single digit subtraction

- If a player can add their numbers in their head, they get an extra 2 points.
