

WORD MEMORY

Create a tray with 15-20 labelled items (e.g., apple labelled 'apple,' soap labelled 'soap'). Cover tray with a blanket and bring it to the child(ren).

Remove blanket for 1 min. and tell the child(ren) to memorize the items and words on the tray. Give them 1 min. to write down all items they can remember.

Re-cover the tray and take it into another room; remove one or two items.

Present tray again and remove blanket, only this time the kids have to guess which items are missing. Have them write down the item(s) on a piece of paper.
