

Pirate's Watch

Ages: 5-12

Building Skills In: addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, order of operations

Number of Players: 2-6

Materials: 2 dice, blank clock face for each player (included), buttons (or other counters)

Brief Description: Players use their math facts to cover up all the numbers on the Pirate's Watch. First one to fill up their watch wins!

Directions:

1. All the players roll one dice. Whoever gets the highest goes first.
2. Player 1 rolls both dice.
3. They decide which operation to use (addition, subtraction, multiplication, division).
4. On the Pirate's Watch, put a button over the number that is the sum, difference, product, or quotient that results from your roll.
5. Player 1 continues until they aren't able to cover a number.
6. Once a player fills in the whole watch, they win the game!

Variations:

- Add more dice and require that all dice be used in the math sentence.
- Use this to practice the Order of Operations.
- For early learners, limit the operations to addition and subtraction.
